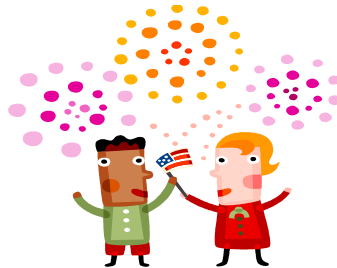

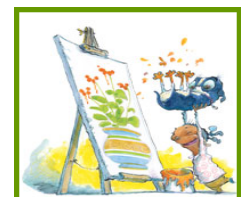

United Way of Lebanon County knows that for many families who are struggling, the basic supplies & book bags their children need to start school have become a luxury they can't afford . . .

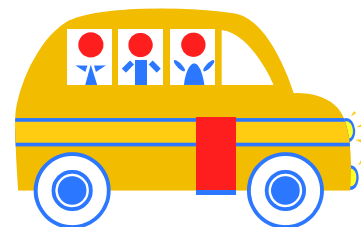
That's where you come in!
