

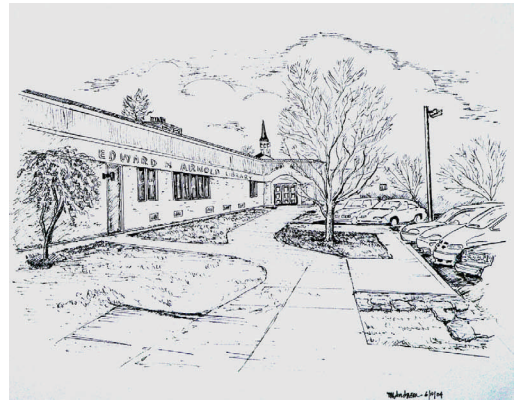

The Stolen Child By Keith Donohue



Looking for a grown-up fairy tale? Look no further than *The Stolen Child*, written by Keith Donohue. Based partially on a poem by Yeats, and on folktales from long ago, this story tells of Henry Day. Henry is a young boy who runs away from home one day, and finds himself stolen from his family. In his place, a changeling has taken over his life - this new Henry Day has waited nearly 100 years to become a boy again. Now Henry is a changeling named Aniday and he must cope with living with the other changelings in the forest. The chapters alternate between Henry and Aniday. This is an absorbing, fascinating story - a wonderful summer read!

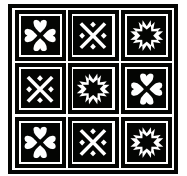
