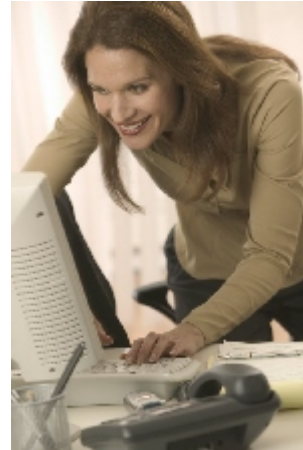


Who Will Bella Choose?
