### John's Story

Taking a step back in time to first century Rome and its empire, Lahaye and Jenkins retell the story of a portion of the life of Christ and of the last remaining disciple, John. Not only has John outlived all the other original disciples, he has seen the destruction of the temple in Jerusalem, and the message of the Christ spread across thousands of miles. It contains a creative idea about how the gospel of John came to be written, and how the early Christians formed their churches and learned from each other. John's gospel has always been considered different from the other three, and this novel helps show why. It also shows how quickly dissenting and heretical thought grew up amongst the first followers.

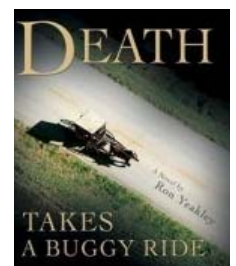
