September 22 6:30PM - The Tuesday Evening Book Group will meet. Title TBA.

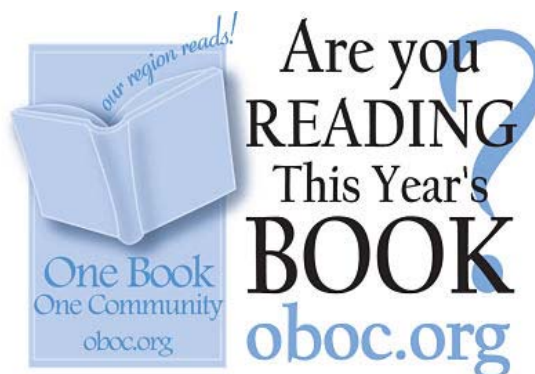

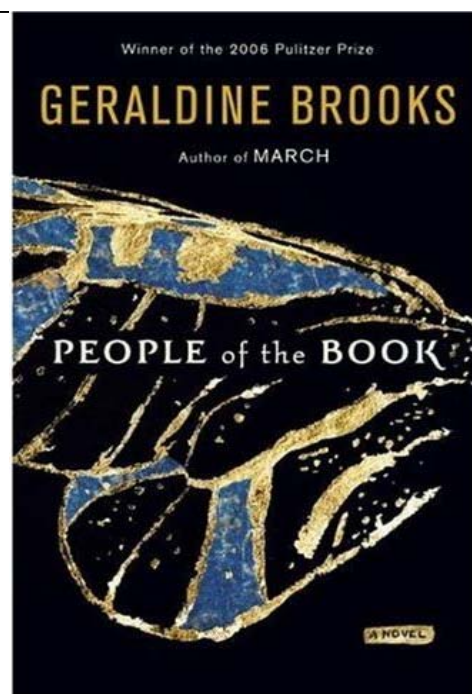

Book Review Corner

People of the Book By Geraldine Brooks



Brooks' work of historical fiction, based on the real-life story of the Sarajevo Haggadah, is a page-turner, and the 2009 One Book One Community selection! The Sarajevo Haggadah is an illustrated text that was used by Jews during Passover. After several brushes with destruction, it now resides in the National Museum of Bosnia and Herzegovina in Sarajevo. Brooks imagines the experiences of the Haggadah during each stage of its journey, as conservator Hanna Heath investigates how a butterfly wing, a white hair, a wine stain, and salt crystals came to be among the pages. Shuffled in with these chapters are ones about Hanna, her relationship with her mother, and with the National Museum librarian who is the current guardian of the book, but the search for the details of the book's history are the best part.

Whether your interest is in mysteries, book history, Judaism, Islam, or Christianity, you'll find enjoyment in this book.
